John's parents were both Chinese, but lived in Korea. Grace is Korean by birth. They have one son - **Peter**. John works full-time at the mission, while Grace holds down an afternoon job at Macon Mall. They are hard working servants of our Lord. I'm so glad our church is able to cooperate in sponsoring this mission along with the Rehoboth Baptist Association. A great need at the Chinese mission is for someone to teach children's Sunday School - in English. Their Sunday School begins at 11 a.m. I wonder if there isn't someone in our church who could assist - maybe some of our folk who could rotate this responsibility. The Chinese Mission meets at the Mission Launch Center (formerly Crestview Baptist Church) on Highway 41. Won't you pray about this opportunity?

When I drove up this morning, I noticed all the work going on around our pond site. New dirt has been hauled in and spread out and hay and grass seed spread. I noticed a man on a tractor-rig and drove out and found **Mr. Talmadge Segars** behind the wheel. Mr. Segars came to Christ last year and was baptized at our church. He has rarely missed a Sunday since. Although a senior adult, he attends our contemporary service. He has spent most of his life farming. Although he can't walk very well, he said, "I can go on this tractor all day long." What a great treasure we have in people like Mr. Segars. May we all find something constructive to do for the Lord.

A week ago Saturday, a special birthday party was held for **Mrs. Elizabeth Newsome**, in honor of her **100th Birthday**, which actually fell on October 4. Many friends, family and church members were able to attend and I was one of them. What a joyful occasion! Elizabeth is a charter member of our church, and that means that she has served this church 50 of her 100 years.
