From The Shepherd's Heart

A new year is upon us! On the one hand, many things remain the same. But on the other, the new year also brings new opportunities. The Bible reflects both hands. It says, 'There is nothing new under the sun.' (Ecclesiastes 1:9). Yet, our Lord says, 'Behold, I make all things new!' (Revelation 21:5).

I believe God wants to do some new things in our midst this year. We have already had a banner first quarter in church growth (up 25% over the same period the previous year!) Yet, I believe God wants to add many new persons to our fellowship in 2007. But that's not all. If he does, the wine will burst the skins, and both the wine and the wineskins will be ruined. No, he pours new wine into new wineskins.' (Mark 2:21-22)

The teaching is unmistakable. If we want to be able to receive all the new things that God has for us, we must have a new heart.

I don't want to miss anything God has for me. Join me this Sunday in coming before the Lord with a new heart, ready for Him to pour into us His new wine.

By the way - God worked a great miracle that past Sunday in allowing us to receive enough money to shatter our **Lottie Moon Christmas Offering** goal of \$50,000. **The final total was \$58,766.07!** Praise the Lord and a great thanks to everyone who gave sacrificially that our international missionaries may continue their work in a way that brings glory to Him.

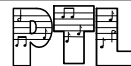
