From The Shepherd's Heart

Evangelism is on my heart today. Do you know what that word means? It comes from the ancient Greek word *euangelos* - which literally means 'good news.' Later, as the English language began to take shape, the word in Middle English was 'godspell' from which we get our word 'gospel' - which, again, means 'good news.'

The Gospel of Jesus Christ is Good News. As we share the good news, we are involved in Evangelism.

This is a day of good news all around Middle Georgia - especially in Houston County. The population is growing, the economy is good, the future of Robins Air Force Base is secure, new homes and businesses are going up all around us, our school system is wonderful. We are, in many ways, enjoying the best days in our relatively short history.

And yet, the estimates are that 65-70% of the people in Houston County are unchurched. Despite all our great churches, we are actually *losing ground* to the competition of humanism and secularism. *There has never been a time when the Good News of Jesus Christ was more urgently needed than now.*

I was watching a documentary about Wal-Mart recently, and was struck by this fact: Wal-Mart does not take its competition lightly. Despite the fact that it is - by far and away - the largest retailer in the world, it still sweats every move by its closest competitors. I heard a major executive describe their attitude as 'running scared' every morning that they are going to lose ground! There is not one bit of apathy in their organization.

And what about ours? Sometimes, I think that we (I mean us and other churches in our area) have arrived. We want to sit back on our recent successes, and as a result, we become apathetic. We become unconcerned about the competition.

Now, the competition is *not* other churches. The competition, again, is secularism and humanism - a lukewarm society which serves as a host to the incubation and growth of every kind of evil organism. And our apathy only adds to its growth.

The only answer is the Good News of Jesus Christ. We must be *fervent* in sharing it. That's why, this spring at Central Baptist Church will be 'All about Evangelism.' From our FAITH training program, to my Wednesday night series beginning January 17, to the Go Tell Crusade on April 29 - May 2 - my heart will be to see our church operating on all its 'evangelical cylinders.' Will you join me in this passion?
