From The Shepherd's Heart

I had an opportunity today to attend the annual National Prayer Luncheon at Robins Air Force Base. It was a joy to see so many of our church members - active military personnel, civilian and contractors - in attendance among the several thousand who gathered at the Museum of Aviation. The special speaker was Lt. (Retired) Clebe McClary, U.S.M.C. McClary is a very patriotic Christian who left his college coaching position (when he saw an American flag being burned) and joined the United States Marines. After Officer Candidate School, he found himself in Vietnam as platoon leader of the 1st Recon Battalion. On his 19th recon patrol, Clebe and his unit were engaged by a suicide squad of North Vietnamese. He fought bravely, but two explosions resulted in the loss of his left arm and eye and other injuries. Over the next two years, he underwent 30 surgeries and many hours of physical therapy. He was awarded three purple hearts, the Silver Star and the Bronze star for his bravery in battle. Although raised in the church and acquainted with scripture, he and his wife came to Christ after hearing former New York Yankees infielder Bobby Richardson give his Christian testimony. Since that time, Clebe has used his testimony to inspire thousands of people to faith in Christ and courage to overcome their circumstances.

McClary is fond of using acronyms. One funny one was ARMY (Aren't Really Marines Yet.) But another was FIDO (Forget It; Drive On.) Two thoughts occurred to me. First, if a man who has suffered such loss can still have such a sense of humor, what about you and me? Second, many of us are stuck and wallowing in something that happened to us months or even years before when what we need to do is get on with the rest of our lives. Those kind of admonitions from someone like me might come off as trite or common. But from McClary, they really make sense because he is the living proof. And it was Jesus Christ who made the difference in his life.

It was refreshing, in this day of political correctness and very careful staging to be fair to all religions, that Clebe McClary was unashamed of Jesus Christ and to speak the truth.
