From The Shepherd's Heart

Last Sunday was a truly remarkable day. Our special guest - **Rev. James Walker of Watchman Fellowship** - certainly captured our interest and our hearts with his messages on Counterfeit Christianity and Mormonism. The Sunday morning message will be available by ordering a CD from our office and you will be able to download it off our website next week. The evening message is only available from James Walker at www.watchman.org. I hope that all of us will now realize how easy it is to be led away from true Christianity and will be very careful - especially when dealing with groups like Jehovah's Witnesses or Mormons.

Groups like Mormons and Jehovah's Witnesses have the right in America to practice their beliefs. If someone tried to rob them of those rights, I would be the first to defend them. To fail to defend them would be a failure at defending our own religious liberty. **HOWEVER**, let me emphatically say that we should also be equipped and ready to defend our beliefs *against* these counter-Christian cults. We need to make every effort to appropriately indoctrinate our own so that we will not fall prey to their false teachings.

I want to especially warn parents of underage children and teenagers: **BE VERY CAREFUL ABOUT ALLOWING YOUR CHILDREN TO SPEND TIME IN THE HOMES OF MORMONS, JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES AND OTHER CULTS.** My advice is to never allow them to spend the night in one of these homes, nor to attend their church services or activities. Instead, invite them to *your* church and into *your* homes. Mormons, Jehovah's Witnesses and other cults are fanatically committed to converting your kids. They believe they are the only true churches. They will do nearly anything to divide your kids from you and your family. Please don't fall for their family values cover. Their false truths are well veiled and your kids will not be able to tell the difference.

I know that what I am writing will seem like prejudice and bigotry to some. But I am willing to run that risk. A shepherd protects his flock from the wolves, and that is what I am trying to do.

Thanks again for your support expressed in last week's attendance and also in your love offering for the Watchman Fellowship. It is a good work worthy of our support.

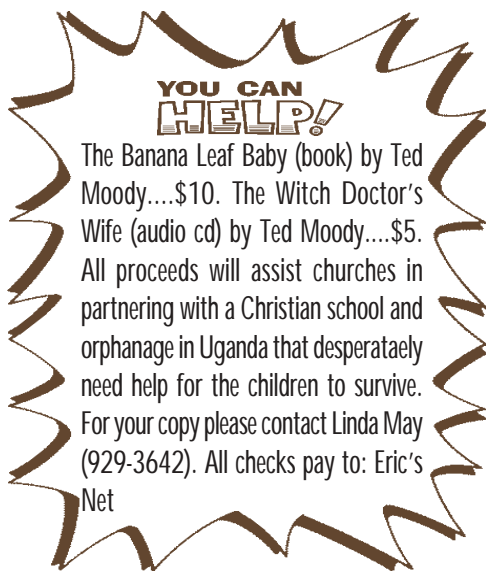
