## From The Shepherd's Heart

### Reflections on 9/11



I'm writing this article on the sixth anniversary of the **September 11, 2001** terrorist attacks on our nation. Most of us can remember where we were and what we were doing when we heard the news. I was at a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Georgia Baptist Convention in Atlanta. I remember us all kneeling in prayer and our Executive Director, **Dr. Robert White**, praying a heartfelt and weeping prayer. I rushed home and we put together a special prayer service for that night. It was a packed house. Everywhere you turned, people were praying.

And we still need to pray. Six years later, we find ourselves in a very unpopular war with faithful and valiant men and women from our armed services constantly in harm's way. Different sides of the political aisle argue and contend about the best resolution for our situation in Iraq and Afghanistan. But I can't get the picture out of my mind of men and women kneeling and praying together in the aisles of our churches on 9/11. And I can't help but think that the answer still lies in fervently seeking God, as individuals and as a nation. Whatever else we do, dear people, let us pray. And God promises in his word, "Then from heaven will I hear, forgive them of their sins, and heal their land." (2 Chronicles 7:14)

### Partner Churches

Many of you may not be aware that we are currently financially supporting two partner churches. A number of people went out from our church with **Steve Wood** and planted a church called **The River** here in **Warner Robins**. Last Sunday, they celebrated their first anniversary with exactly 300 in attendance. We are also partners with a new church plant in the **Winder, GA**, area, called **The Church at River Hills**. Their pastor is **Chip Wheeler**, who is the son-in-law of our church members, **Jim and Joan Turner**. This past Sunday, the Church at River Hills was launched with 135 in attendance. Praise the Lord for what he is doing through these churches and for the Lord allowing us to have a small part. We have received at least two more requests to support new church starts in the last few months. It would seem that God is trying to tell us something. I hope you will pray with me about how we can be more involved in helping churches to be launched. It's one of the most effective ways to carry out the Great Commission.
