Although we did not achieve our High Attendance Day goal of 1200 in Sunday School, we did have **1081** - our **largest Sunday School attendance this year**. The **worship attendance of 1401 was second only to Easter Sunday**. Thanks to every Sunday School class for your efforts!

A Banner Year

Many of you know that, as a Southern Baptist Church, our church year of record runs from October through September. This past Sunday closed out our **2006-2007 church year**. I thought you would be interested to know that we saw **85 persons baptized and 166 other additions to our church membership by statement and letter, for a total of 251 persons added to our membership. All of these are records** during the twelve years of my tenure as your Pastor. Having said this, I do believe we can do much better. I would like to see us exceed 100 baptisms and a total of 300 additions in the 2007-2008 church year. It all starts again this Sunday. Won't you reach out to someone who needs Christ and a church home?

Third Floor is Completed!

We have just completed the third floor of our facility. The third floor includes additional educational space above both the south and north wings and is connected by a long hallway that overlooks the main foyer. **The south wing** (toward Russell Parkway) includes four large classrooms separated by three movable walls, which can be opened up to create a very large space for seminars, receptions and other occasions. **The north wing** includes a very large and open space for children's church on Sunday mornings, Kidz Rock on Wednesday evenings, and will be available for other events as scheduled. Both wings include men's and women's restrooms and a small kitchenette. This space will give us room to grow. Feel free to go up and look around. **We will host a short dedication ceremony for this floor immediately following the 10:30 worship service on October 14.**

Please remember our **Fall High School retreat** this weekend. About 75 persons will be traveling up to South Carolina for a wonderful weekend of Bible Study, inspiration and fun. Please pray for a safe weekend, for souls to be saved and our high school youth to be more united than ever.
